18-19 OCTOBER, 2014

Welcome to FlamesCon 2014, soldier!

This year, we have a lot of events lined up to keep you entertained for the entire weekend. We've got *Flames Of War* tournaments, *Spartacus, Firefly*, and *Sons of Anarchy* boardgames, a *Dust: Battlefield* tournament, display tables of new releases, and the Iron Cross painting competition. We welcome back to FlamesCon the popular Flames in the Sky aerial combat game.

We have a little something for everyone, so get ready for a weekend of fun!

We have the pleasure of offering a tournament for all three periods of *Flames Of War*, as well as a Vietnam story-driven event. The main event will be our Late War Tournament, supported by two one-day tournaments (Early War on Saturday, and Mid War on Sunday).

TOURNAMENTS

LATE WAR TOURNAMENTS (1500 POINTS)

Saturday & Sunday (18-19 October)

You have two options with the Late War Tournament. You can either play the whole event (six rounds, three per day) or you can choose to play one day (three rounds, Saturday or Sunday). When you register, be sure to indicate your preference so that we can reserve your space.

This tournament will run on Saturday (18 October) to Sunday (19 October) consisting of three games per day. Each game has been allocated 2¼ hours per game with a short break in between each game.

Schedule: Registration for the Late War Tournament begins at 8:00am. The first game round begins at 9:00am. The last game will finish by 4:30pm.

EARLY WAR TOURNAMENT (1500 POINTS)

Saturday (18 October)

The Early War Tournament is scheduled for Saturday morning and will run parallel to the Late-War event. Spaces are limited, so be sure to register early to reserve your spot.

This tournament will run on Saturday (18 October) and will consist of three games. Each game has been allocated 21/4 hours per game with a short break in between each game.

Schedule: Registration for the Early War Tournament begins at 8:00am. The first game round begins at 9:00am. The last game will finish by 4:30pm.

MID WAR TOURNAMENT (1500 POINTS)

Sunday (19 October)

The Mid War Tournament is scheduled for Sunday morning and will run parallel to the Late-War event. Spaces are limited, so be sure to register early to reserve your spot.

This tournament will run on Sunday (19 October) and will consist of three games. Each game has been allocated 2¹/₄ hours per game with a short break in between each game.

Schedule: Registration for the Mid War Tournament begins at 8:00am. The first game round begins at 9:00am. The last game will finish by 4:30pm.

DUST BATTLEFIELD TOURNAMENT (100 POINTS)

Sunday (19 October)

We're pleased to announce FlamesCon's first *Dust Battlefield Tournament!* It is scheduled for Sunday morning. Spaces are limited, so be sure to register early to reserve your spot.

This tournament will run on Sunday (19 October) and will consist of four games. Each game has been allocated 1¹/₄ hours per game with a short break in between each game.

Schedule: Registration for the DUST: Battlefield Tournament begins at 8:00am. The first game round begins at 9:00am. The last game will finish by 3:30pm.





BOARDGAMES & DEMONSTRATION TABLES

This year we have some exciting boardgames lined up, including Gale Force Nine's *Spartacus: A Game of Blood and Treachery, Firefly: The Game*, and the new *Sons of Anarchy!* On Sunday we will be running the inaugural Gale Force Nine Cup; a *Spartacus* and *Sons of Anarchy* tournament where players will engage in a test of skills and cunning across two rounds of *Spartacus* and (depending on time) either one or two rounds of *Sons of Anarchy!*

A demo table of *Firefly* and *Sons of Anarchy* will be available at all times so you can have a look at the expanding range of Gale Force Nine boardgames.

GALE FORCE NINE CUP

Sunday (19 October)

Swords, sandals, motorbikes, contraband and Glocks, get ready for the Gale Force Nine Cup! Spaces are limited, so be sure to register early to reserve your spot.

This tournament will run on Sunday (19 October) and will consist of three or four games. Each game has been allocated 1½-2 hours per game (depending on the round) with a short break in between each game.

Schedule: Registration for the Spartacus Tournament begins at 9:00am. The first game round begins at 9:30am. The last game will finish by 4:00pm.



PAINTING COMPETITION

IRON CROSS PAINTING COMPETITION

Saturday & Sunday (18-19 October)

We will be running the annual Iron Cross Painting competition. This event will run all day Saturday and Sunday.

Players can bring their pieces for judging at any time up to 12:00pm on Sunday. Judging will commence on Sunday. Contestants will need to notify the event coordinators as to when they intend to pick up their entry, either on Saturday night or Sunday afternoon. This will help the judges prioritise their judging schedule to accommodate players attending Saturday only.

The competition has multiple categories. Participants can enter one or more of these categories. Independent judges score the pieces and each entry is measured against the set of competition rules outlined by the event team.

Iron Cross Painting Competition Categories:

Best Infantry Platoon (all infantry teams)

Best Tank Platoon (all tank or transport teams)

Best Other Platoon (gun, cavalry, or mixed teams)

Best Model (single piece, including objectives)

Awards & Prizes: Awards will be given based on merit.

GENERAL OPEN GAMING


Saturday Night (18 October)
